



A Draught of nine acres and ninety eight perches of land with 6 p. cent  
for Roads. part of a tract of land surveyed in pursuance of an  
Order N<sup>o</sup> 5305 to John Taylor dated 27<sup>th</sup> December 1768 said  
to contain 310<sup>3</sup>/10 acres. Situate in Armagh township in Mifflin  
County. but found to contain only 301<sup>9</sup>/824 perches with 6 p. cent  
by resurvey made 16<sup>th</sup> June 1806 in pursuance of an Order of  
the Board of property dated 20<sup>th</sup> February 1806. Divided 16<sup>th</sup>  
September 1812.
