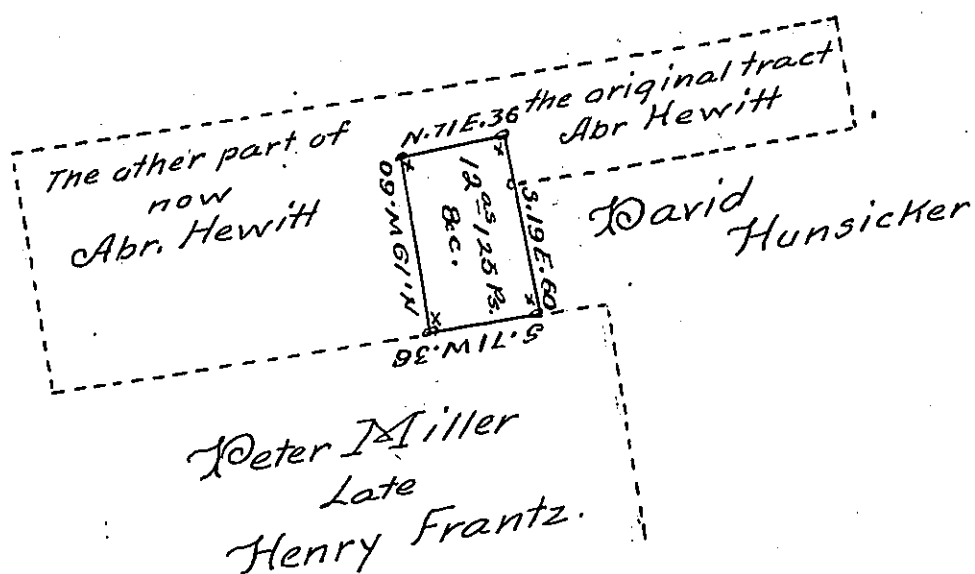


# BLUE MOUNTAIN



DRAFT of a tract of woodland situate at the foot of the Blue Mountain in Heidelberg township, Lehigh County, containing Twelve acres, one hundred and twenty five perches and allowance of six per cent. for roads &c. Surveyed for Levi Hawk; the fourth day of Dec. A. D. 1872, being a part of a larger tract of One hundred acres and allowance originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Henry German, dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of January A. D. 1821.
