



A DRAFT of a tract of land situated in the Township of Albany and now and County of Berks, containing 247 acres, 84 perches and allowance of six per cent. for roads, etc. Constructed from the original for Benjamin Trexler and Mahlon Trexler et. al. the first day of December, A.D. 1899, it being part of a larger tract containing two hundred and seventy acres, one hundred and four perches and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to George Goltner dated the twenty-eighth day of November 1750.
