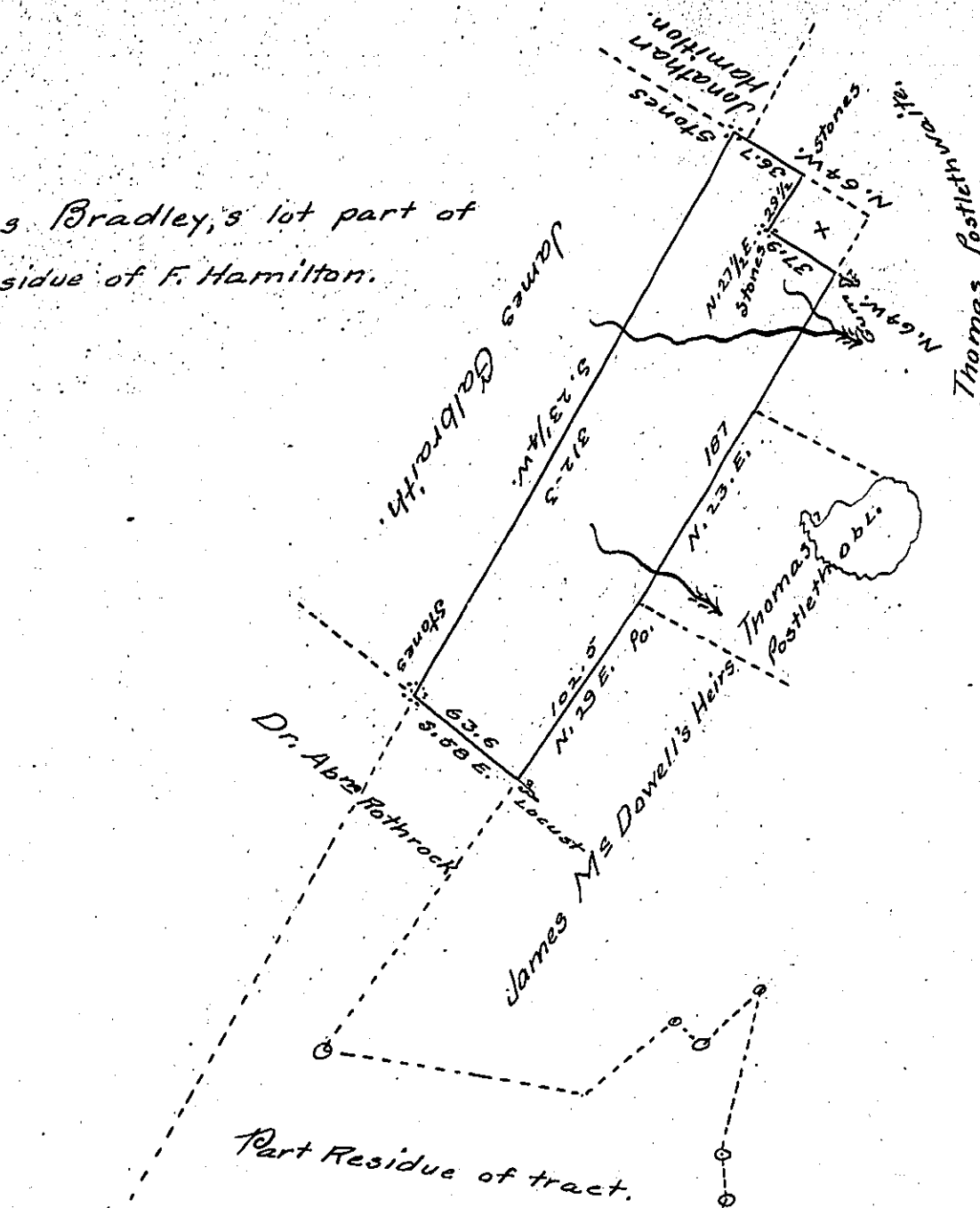


+ James Bradley's lot part of the Residue of F. Hamilton.
