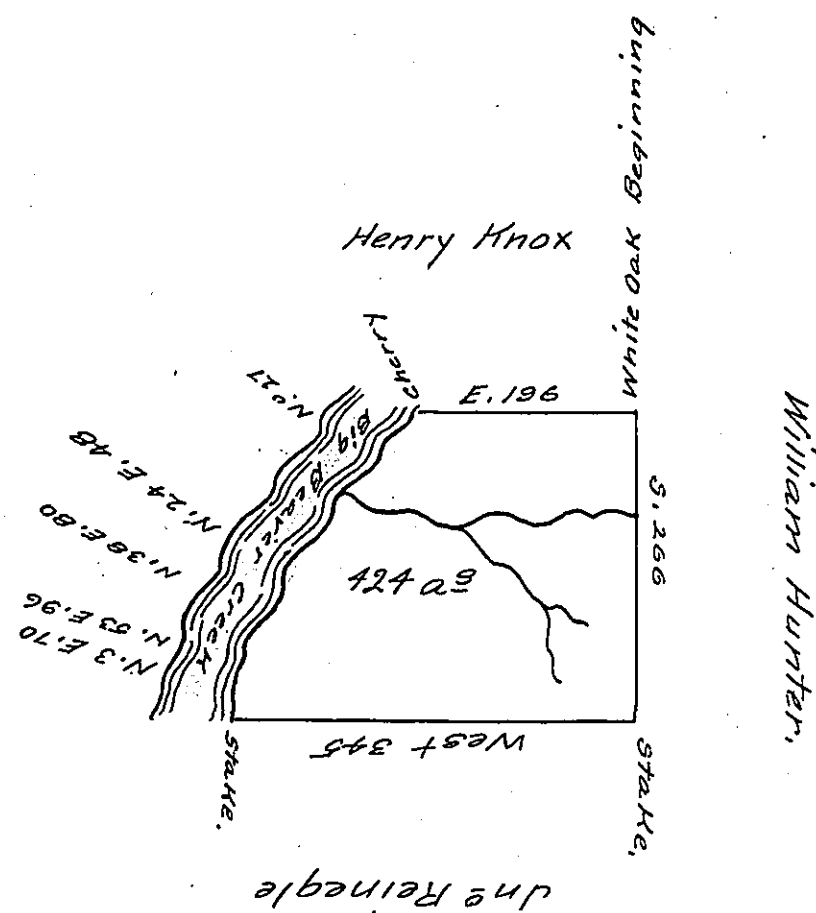

Situate North and West of the River Ohio on the East Bank of Big Beaver Creek adjoining Land granted to William Hunter Called STATEFORD Containing four hundred and twenty four acres & allowance.
