A Draft of a piece of Land situate in Washington Township in the County of Franklin (formerly in Antrim Township in the County of Cumberland) containing seventy three Acres 66 Perches and allowance of six P Cent & being part of a Tract of 177 Acres 125 & allowance which appears by a Draft Signed William Lyon (who was an Assistant to John Armstrong U.S.) to have been Surveyed on two Warrants one to Daniel Hendricks Dated 1st October 1754 and the other to Jacob Wertz bearing Date 4th May 1763 - Resurveyed the above 12th April 1803.
