



The above is a draught of a survey situate on the waters of the South fork of Ten mile Creek in the County of Greene (formerly Washington.) Called John's Place made on the 21st day of August 1797 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Gray (son of David Gray) dated the ninth day of November 1796 containing Seventy & three fourths acres with the allowance of Six P. Cent for roads &c.
