Being a part of a larger tract of land containing 294^{as} & allowance which was surveyed for Mary Parker the 31st of Octr. 1771 in pursuance of an Order N^o 2568 dated the 3^d of April 1769 Situate on the waters of Monemaugh River in Derry Township and in the County of Westmoreland
