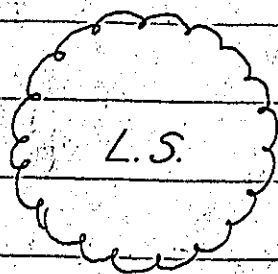


A draught of a tract of land Situate in Conneautt Town-
