



By Virtue of a Warrant granted to Samuel Harrish dated the 28th of Nov^r. A. Dom 1745 there was resurveyed on the 22nd day of May 1807 (by Henry M. Richards then Deputy Surveyor.) unto George Ege, Esquire, in right of the said Samuel Harrish the above described tract of land situate in Heidelberg township Berks County containing one hundred and seventy acres one hundred and thirteen perches and the allowance of six per cent &c.
