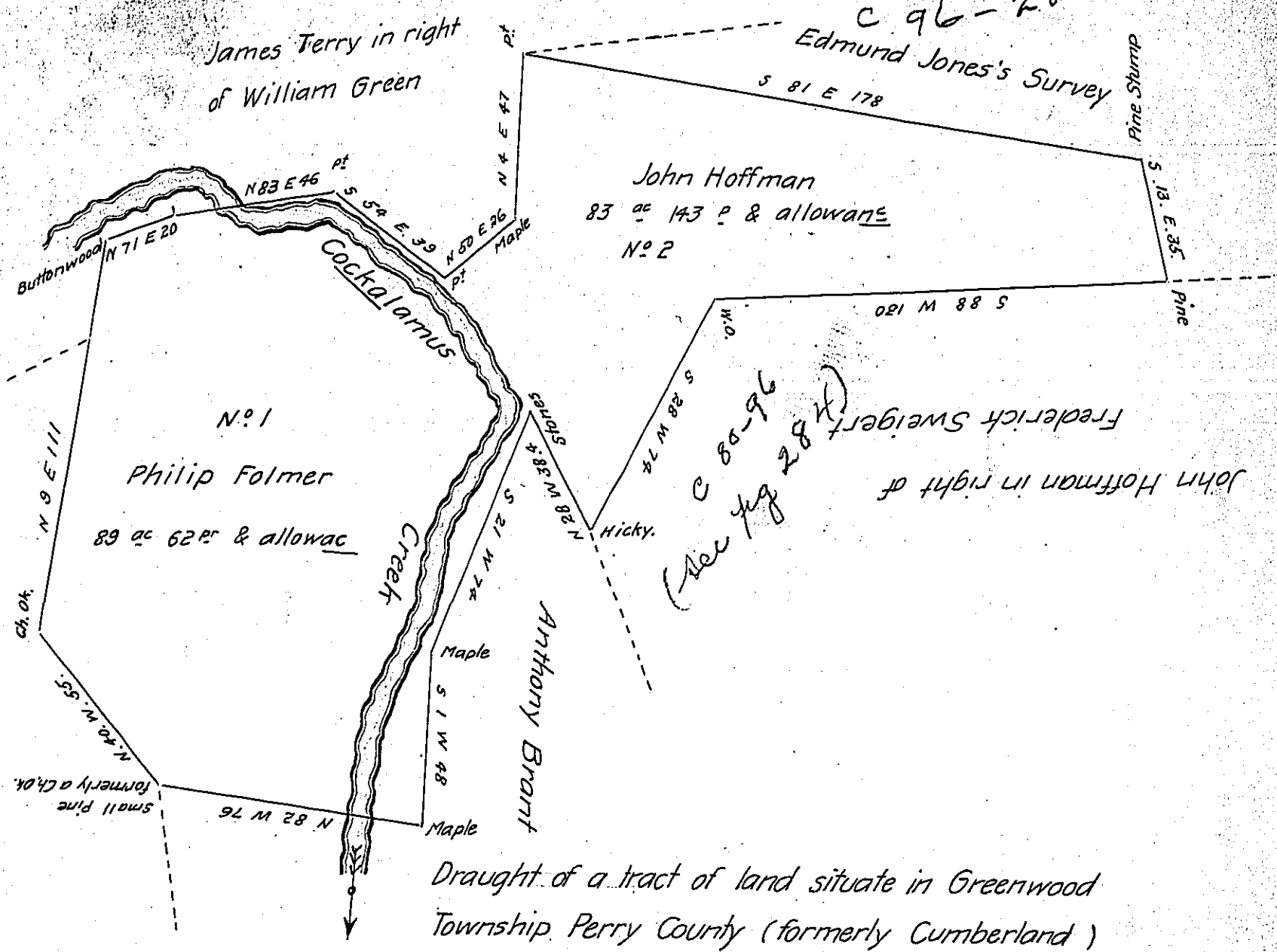


Philip Folmer in Right of
