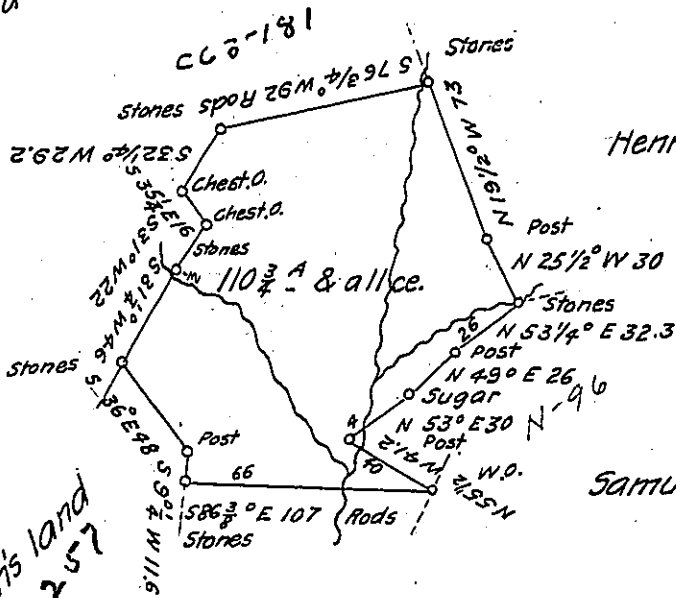

The above tract is situate in the township of Franklin and County of Fayette on the waters of Boldins Run, Jane Gilleland and family residing thereon. There is about 50 acres cleared on this tract, and a dwelling house and stable erected thereon. It appears to have been settled for 30 or 40 years. It was surveyed on the 30th day of July 1839 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Jane Gilleland on the eighth day of July A.D. 1839 for 100 acres.
