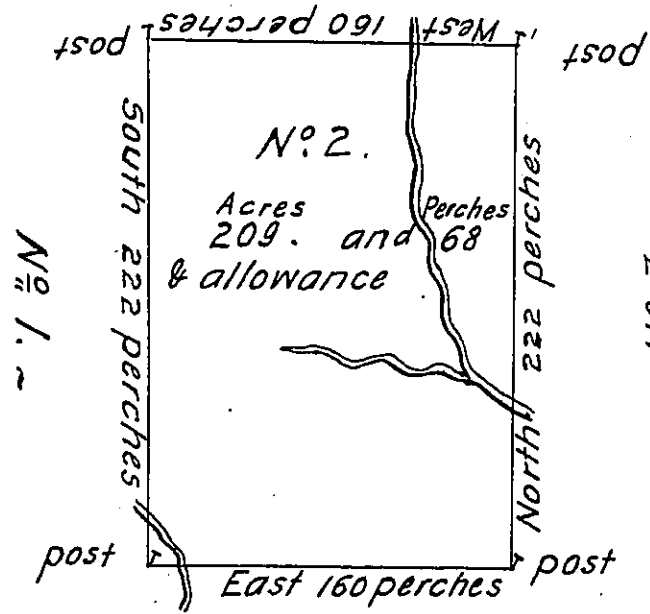

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the Sale of Certain Lands therein Mentioned and by Virtue of a Commission to me Directed under Hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup>. Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup>. the 14<sup>th</sup> day of Aug(obl) 1783.

The above tract containing two Hundred and Nine Acres and and Sixty Eight Perches and allowance of 6  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent for roads &c was Surveyed on the 31<sup>st</sup> of May 1785 by -
