Who again by his Deed Poll of the 6<sup>th</sup> March Anno 1767. Sold and conveyed his Right to the Same to John Shantz for whom the Same was Resurveyed By order of the Surveyor General on the 27<sup>th</sup> February Anno 1767. ~ And Now drawn again for him the Said John Shantz. ~ On the 14<sup>th</sup> May Anno 1785.
