



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 13<sup>th</sup> May 1747 Surveyed the 20 July 1750 to Jacob Fry the above described tract of land formerly Situate in Allemingle Philadelphia County now in Lynn township Northampton County containing One hundred and thirty three Acres sixty perches and the allowance of Six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent & C<sup>o</sup> taken from a draft of James Scull's late Deputy Surveyor the 29 Nov<sup>r</sup> 1811.
