William Fry produced a Certificate from the Com<sup>rs</sup> for adjusting Claims and settling Titles to Lands in the Counties of Yohogania Mono- ngalia and Ohio for four hundred acres Land in this County on the Waters of Peters Creek <sup>in Peters To P.</sup> to include his Settlement made in the year 1773
