



Situate in Licking Creek Township Fulton County formerly Bedford County, containing One hundred and fifty two acres with the usual allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c., Surveyed June 9<sup>th</sup> 1854 on Warrant granted to James C. Austin and Andrew Fisher for 150<sup>acs</sup> dated February 15<sup>th</sup> 1848.

Sir there was a return of Survey upon the above warrant which which interferred with Mathias Hanns Improvement for which reason said Survey was rejected, and by the minutes of the Board of Property dated July 5<sup>th</sup> 1849 the County Surveyor was directed to throw out said interference and includ adjacent vacant land so as to fill said warrant which was done
