


In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Simon Hind Bearing date the 12th day of June 1811. surveyed on the second day of November Following unto the aforesaid Simon Hind the above described tract of land containing two hundred and thirty eight acres & one hundred and sixteen perches and allowance proportioned at six per cent. situate on the south side of the Kiskaminitis River adjoining lands of Stephen Rybolt on the West Martin Best on the East John Brown on the South and Simon Hinds other land, in Washington township in the County of Westmoreland including an improvement thereon consisting of about Eighty acres of land cleared & fenced together with a Dwelling House & Barn and other buildings First improved in March 1773
