



Situate on the North side of the West branch of Susquehanna River about two miles below the mouth of Andersons creek in Chinglidamoose township, and County of Clearfield.

Surveyed the 1st of April 1811 to Hugh Hall Esqr in pursuance of a Warrant, dated the fourth of December 1810. Containing four hundred and ten acres forty three perches & allowance & c.
