



Situate on a small branch emptying into the north side of the Monongahela River in Luzerne Township Fayette County & Surveyed the 10th day of April 1829 in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 17th day of March 1829 for 50 acres.

There is about 30 acres cleared, a log house, barn &c. Small apple orchard, also a family residing on this Tract of land.

It may also be observed, that there is a deviation from the Davidson line N. 6. W. agreeable to the copy of survey procured from the Land Office (for there has been 2 or 3 old surveys of Davidson) but the occupants now claim and have improved for many years past as the lines above represent one of the old lines run from A to B another from D to C while neither of them recorded in my office agree with that from which a copy has been ob-

tained said to have been made 25th Oct. 1786. F. L.
