


His other Land.



Situate in Shrewsbury township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 30<sup>1/42</sup> perches and allowance for being part of a larger tract of Land Originally Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Beck bearing date the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. 1798. Resurveyed and Divided off from said larger tract of land the 7<sup>th</sup> day of March 1827 at the request of Henry Hess the present owner who desired the same to be returned for confirmation.
