



The above is a Draught of a Survey Made May the 18th day 1796 by John Hoge Esq; then Deputy Surveyor Containing two hundred and ten Acres of Land with the allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. In pursuance of a warrant Granted Caleb Johnson the 30th day of March 1796 Situate on Godards Run a Branch of Dunkard Creek in Green Township now Dunkard Township-Called Musgrove.

Two Settlements Made and Continued on the above Discribed tract of Land May 14th day 1813. Stephen Gopen.
