



A Draught of a tract of land situate on Wyalusing Creek, in the Township of Wyalusing Bradford County including the improvements of Jonas Ingham Junct. Consisting of a Dwelling house, Saw Mill, & Fulling Mill, and several acres of improved land, begun 14 Sept<sup>r</sup> 1803. Containing one hundred and Eighty nine acres & twenty six perches, and allowance of six percent for Roads. Surveyed to Jonas Ingham Junct the 21<sup>st</sup> day of January 1818. in pursuance of a warrant dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of January 1817 by  
 Jan<sup>y</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> 1820 Jonathan Stevens D.S.
