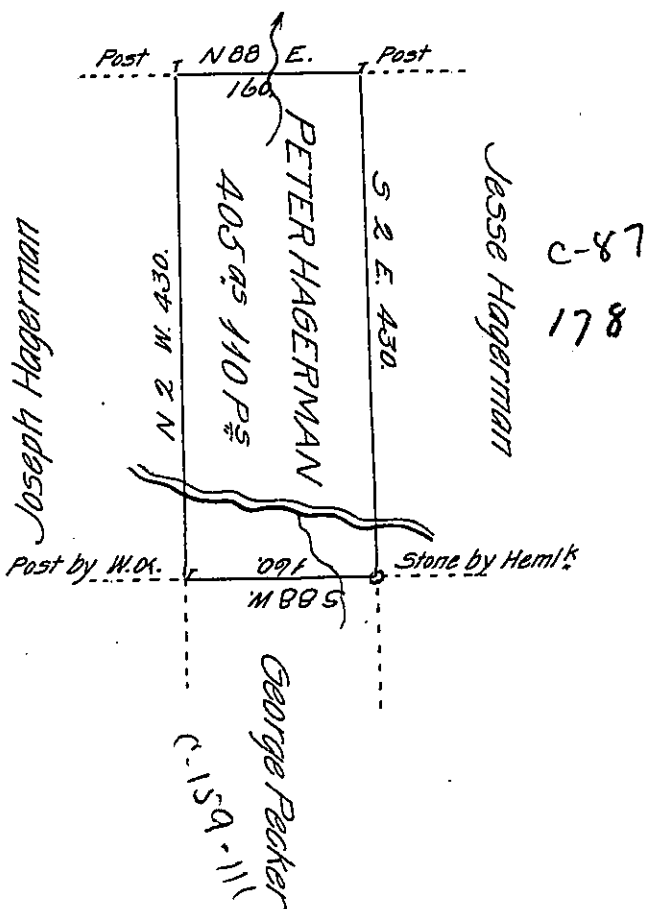

East Branch of Susquehanna — above the mouth of Tioga river in the County of Luzerne containing Four hundred & five Acres & one hundred & ten perches & the allowance of Six P^r Cent.
