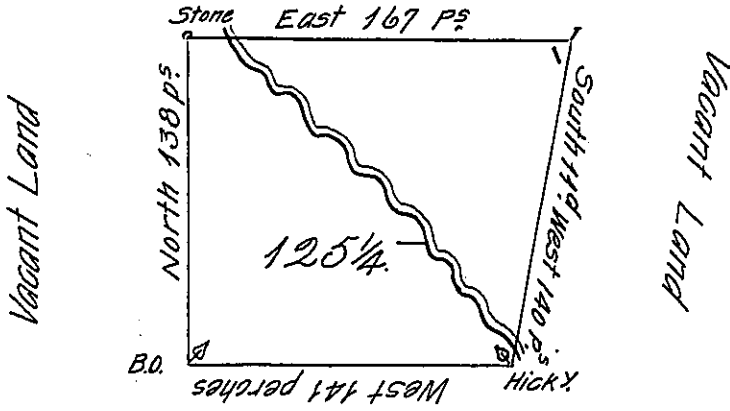


Vacant Land
