



A Draught of a Tract of Land, Situate in Frederick Township in The County of Philadelphia, in the State of Pennsylvania. Containing One Hundred and Six Acres and four Perches of Land. Together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads. For which a Warrant is Said to have been Taken out by one George Krowse. Supposed about The year 1734. or afterwards. Who Sold his Right to The Same to Jacob Howck To whom The Land was Surveyed. Whose Heirs Sold and Conveyed Their Right to the Same To Frederick Lesh, Who again Sold The Same To Nicholas Kunts, (Alias Koontz) for whom The Land now was resurveyed, But he Sold the greatest Part Thereof To Peter Rosko and Kept about The fourth Part Thereof for himself.
