



The Draught of a Tract of Land belonging to Matthias Kaler Situate in Robeson Township in Berks County Surveyed the 8th day of the 5 mo. 1782 Beginning at a Stone Corner Thence North Sixty four Degrees East By the lands of Thomas Hamilton and Peter Myres Sixty five Perches to a White Oak, Thence North Twenty Eight Degrees East by the said Myres Seventy five perches to a Stone, Thence North Thirty Six Degrees West by the said Peter Myres Land & Land of Mark Bird Seventy Two perches to a Stone, Thence South Seventy Seven Degrees West by Edward Bonsall's Land One hundred and fifteen perches to a Stone, Thence by the Land of William Mervine five courses (Viz) South Twenty Eight Degrees East Fifty Three perches to a Stone, North Seventy Three Degrees East Sixteen perches, South Eleven Degrees East Sixty five Perches, to a Stone, North Sixty four Degrees East four per. to a Stone and South Eleven Degrees East Twenty four perches to the place of beginning Containing 79 Acres beside the Allowance of Six P Cent. Part of a Tract of Land Surd to Henry Holston by Wt. of ye 19th of October 1737.
