



A Draught of a tract of land Situate in White-Hall Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania Containing Forty one acres and 120 Perches of Land together with the usual allowance at six per cent for roads That was surveyed to Michael Harlacher in pursuance of a Warrant granted to him by the Hon^{ble} proprietaries dated the 21st day of February Anno - 1754 Surveyed for the said Michael Harlacher (then intended for his son Daniel) on the 6th August Anno - 1755 By order of William Parsons Esquire Then Deputy Surveyor

P. S. There was a draught for the above returned in 1757 The Warrant was taken out not long before the Survey in the former draft I imagine the left hand course was put down wrong by mistake but may by the above be corrected Drawn again November 21st 1774
