



Situate formerly in Monaghan, now partly in Washington but principally in Franklin township in the County of York, being part of a tract of land containing 94 acres and allowance. Surveyed to Peter Fox March 30. 1790 in pursuance of a Warrant ~~Receipt~~ dated the 28<sup>th</sup> January 1763, granted to Peter Fry. The part within the yellow shaded lines containing Twenty nine acres and sixty two perches and the usual allowance, surveyed and divided off said tract, May 23<sup>rd</sup> 1867 for Jacob Lehmer, the present owner, and at his request returned for Confirmation
