By Warrant from the Proprietaries dated 10th March last, Survey'd unto Hugh Jones the 28th April 1733. a Tract on Cookosing Creek in Lancaster County. Beginning at a White Oak by ye said Creek thence South 40^d West by Vacant land 200 Pches to a Hickery at a corner of George Haines land thence North 50^d West by the 5^d Haines land 172 Pches to a Black Oak thence North 40^d East 200 Pches to a Black Oak thence South 50^d East by Vacant land 172 Pches to the place of Beginning Containing two hundred ^{& three} acres and the allowance of six acres P. Cent.
