



By Virtue of a Warrt from The Hon^{ble} Proprietaries bearing date the 19th day of August Anno Dom 1737

I have surveyd and laid out unto Charles Jones in the Township of Helme in the County of Lancaster on the West side of Susquehanna river Two hundred and two acres of land with allowance of 6. P. Cent Beginning at a Black Oak Thence North twenty five degrees Westerly One hundred and Ninety Pches to a Hickery thence South Sixty five degrees Westerly One hundred eighty one Pches to a Hickery thence South Twenty five degrees Easterly one hundred and Ninety Perches to a black oak thence North Sixty five degrees Easterly One hundred Eighty one Perches to the Place of Beginning
