



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor dated the 28th of
 8^{mo} Anno Dom. 1737, the above described Tract of Land was Surveyed unto Thomas
 James in the Township of Cumru in the County of Lancaster. Beginning at a
 black Oak in a line of Evan Lloyd's land, thence South by Vacant Land 80
 perches to a Post. Thence East by another tract of land of the said Evan Lloyd 219
 to a Post. Thence North Nor West by Vacant Land and the land of Henry Harry 222
 Perches to a Stone. Thence South 47 degrees West by the land of Evan Lloyd 183
 Perches to the place of Beginning. Containing One hundred and sixty four acres
 beside the allowance of six P Cent for Roads
