 thence by the same South East one hundred and two perches and by Vacant
 land ye same Course fifty seven perches to a Post thence by Vacant land South

 one hundred and and fifty nine perches to a Post thence by land of Bartle
 Cooker North East one hundred and sixty perches to ye place of Beginning
 Containing one hundred & fifty acres with the usual allowance of six P. Cent
