



A Draught of a tract of land called "Greenland" Situate about 8 or 9 Miles from the North East Branch of Susq^a River and on the Waters of Roaring Creek adjoining land surveyed for John Backhouse in the County of North-umberland containing three hundred and twenty seven acres & one hundred and thirty eight perches beside the usual allowance of six P. Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 9th day of October 1772. for Owen Jones Jun^r. In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 11th day of September 1772.
