



Situated on a branch of Buffalo Lick Creek, in Brothers Valley Township, Somerset County (late Bedford) The whole tract 226^{ac} & all. was Surveyed in the Year 1775, by Alexander McClean, Esq^r Deputy Surveyor. In pursuance of a warrant dated the 13th day of February 1775; granted to Walter Hayle for 200^{ac}

The above part 107^{ac} 107^{ac} & all. was resurveyed and Divided 27th June 1822, agreeably to the wishes of all concerned, in order that it may blend with an adjoining division of another tract in one patent.
