Originally Surveyed by James Scull, a Deputy Surveyor of said County, as appears by a diagram filed in this Office, in pursuance of a Warrant dated the seventh day of October, A.D. 1771, granted to Stephen Harsh. Resurveyed and returned agreeably to the present bearings, and distances, containing Sixty six acres, three perches, and allowance, &c.
