A Draught of an Island in the River Susquehanna, West Hempfield township, Lancaster County, Opposite to the town of Wrightsville on the West, and the borough of Columbia, on the East. Called Duck Island, Containing five perches, Strict Measure. Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 7th day of June Anno Dom. One thousand eight hundred and twenty two (1822), granted to Abraham Harris.
