



Situate in Manchester township, in the County of York, Containing as above set forth Sixteen Acres, and fifty five perches and allowance & C^a. Being part of a larger tract of 96^{ac} & 147^{pc} & C^a of Land. Originally Surveyed by Charles Lukens, then D.S., on the 10th day of August 1774. In pursuance of a Warrant for 50^{ac} Granted to Simon Heninger, dated 24th August 1745.

Resurveyed & Divided off from the said larger tract on the 28th day of March 1817, for Jacob Fink, at whose request the same is calculated, examined and found correct and returned for confirmation this 6th day of August 1827.
