



Situate in Washington Township, Lycoming County, in the Old Purchase, containing two hundred and twenty eight acres, one hundred and thirteen perches and allowance of six per cent. for roads &c. Being part of a Tract of land surveyed the 9<sup>th</sup> of April 1790, for W<sup>m</sup> Howell, by virtue of his Warrent dated 25<sup>th</sup> of July 1787, by Joseph Wallis, Esq<sup>e</sup>, O.S. Divided the 27<sup>th</sup> of May 1828, for John Eason, agreeable to his Deed poll, dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of December 1801 and now returned for confirmation.
