



A Draught of a Tract of Land. Situate in Dover Township in the County of York. Containing as above set forth 70<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> and the usual allowance of 6 per Cent &c Being part of a larger Tract of 269<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> and the allowance of Land Originally Surveyed on the 22<sup>d</sup> day of February 1767, for Jacob Hoffman on Warrant dated the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September 1762. Re-surveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land by Charles Lukens late D.S on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1775. And now at the request of the owners, VIZ, the Heirs and representatives of Henry Rudy deceased, the above has been Calculated, examined and found to be Correct, and returned for Confirmation the 25<sup>th</sup> day of April, A.D. 1822.
