



Situate in Washington Township Lycoming County on the Waters of White Deer Hole Creek and bounded as above described Resurveyed for the Trustees of the heirs of William Bell on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of August 1840 by Virtue of an order of Resurvey granted by the Board of Property dated the 4<sup>th</sup> July 1840 and on Application No 3758 granted to Jonathan Taylor bearing <sup>date</sup> the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August 1769. Excluding the interference with Matthew Irwin No 1 Contains one hundred and Sixteen acres and Eighty eight perches with allowance of Six per Cent— No 3 Contains twenty acres and fifteen perches with allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c.
