


Jos. Davidson

Containing Sixty acres one hundred nine perches and allowance of six per ct. &c. being a part of a larger tract of Land Resurveyed the fourteenth day of March A.D. 1812. by Jonathan Stevens former Deputy Surveyor in pursuance of a order issued by the Board of Property dated the 9th day of March 1812 originally Surveyed for Charles Haines the 20th day of November 1784 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 1st day of July 1784. The above Resurveyed the 22nd Feby 1842 at the request of Jacob Billheimer
