



The above is a Draught of a Survey made ~~for~~ June 18-1785 for John M^r Donald Assignee of Samuel Irwin in pursuance of a Certificate in the following Words Viz- We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia Yohogonia and Ohio do hereby Certify that Samuel Irwin is entitled to four hundred Acres of Land in Yohogonia County adjoining the Land of Gabriel Cox on the Waters of Monongalia to include his Actual Settlement made in the year one thousand Seven hundred and Sixty nine Also a Right in Preemption to one thousand Acres adjoining thereto. Given under our hands at Coxes fort the Twenty fifth day of January 1780 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
