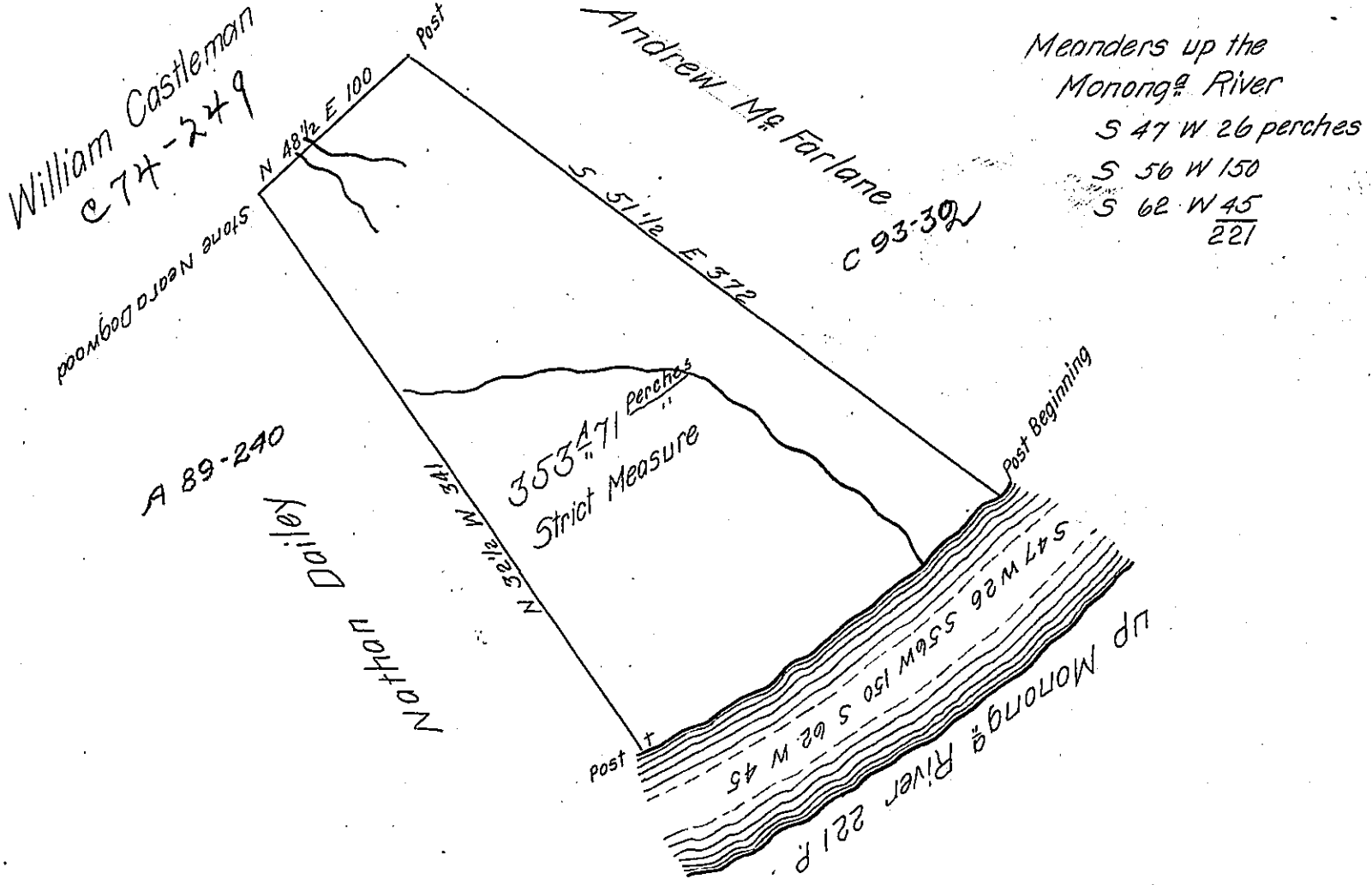

 (to wit.) We the Commissioners for Adjusting the claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania & Ohio do hereby Certify that Moses Hollady is intitled to four hundred Acres of Land in the County of Yohogania Situate on the Waters of Monongalia to include his Settlement made in the year of our Lord Seventeen hundred & Seventy Given under our hands at Cox's fort the third day of February 1780.
