



A Draught of one hundred and sixty one acres and ^{en} seventy nine perches of land & the usual allowance of six pr Cent for roads &c. situate in Derry township Mifflin County surveyed March 26th 1789 and said to contain 161 as 15 ps. and allowance &c. Warrant to Wm Holt & Andrew Gregg dated the 4th day of February 1788. Resurveyed Aug 23rd 1799 & appears to lack 37 acres &c. of the quantity cauled for in the return, which was added to it by virtue of an order of the Bord of Property bearing date the 29th day of July 1799. in favour of John Norris. The green lines shews the addition Resurveyed and examined 11th & 12th April 1833 at the request of John Norris Esq. the present owner and found to be correct as above stated.
