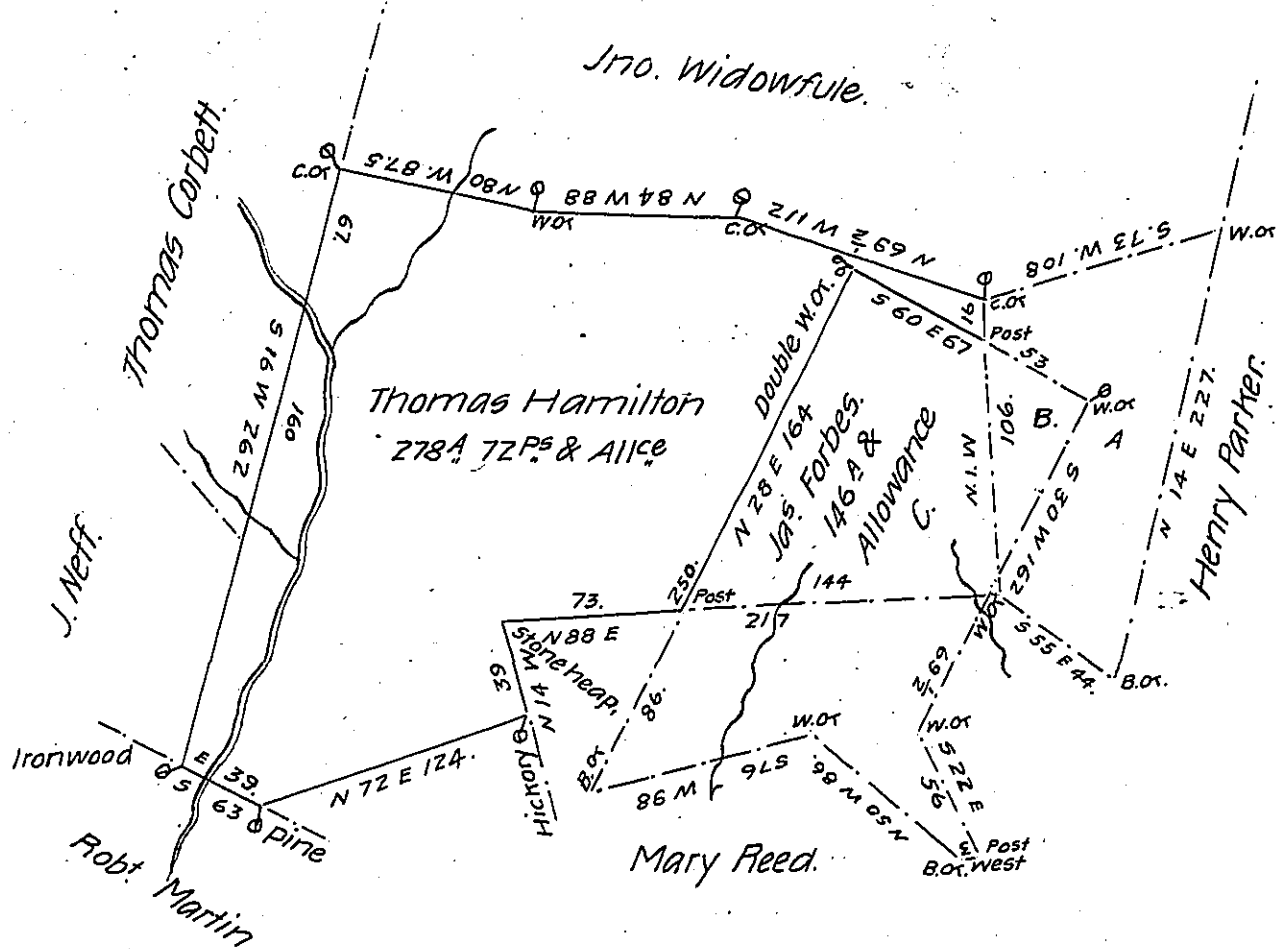


The part of James Forbes marked C. contains seventy-five acres Thirty-nine perches & allowance D.H.

Situate in Loyalsock Township, Lycoming County, in the old purchase, and bounded as above described, containing Two Hundred and Seventy-Eight Acres, Seventy-two perches, and allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed on the 30th day of April 1833, For James McLean, by virtue of an order of the Board of property, dated the 23d day of February 1833 on a warrant in the name of Thomas Hamilton. *
