



By Virtue of two Warrants granted to George Happle one of them dated the 25th of April 1808 and surveyed Oct the 9th 1809 by George Palmer and the other of them dated the 27th of August 1804 and Surveyed the 20th of September 1804 by Jonas Hertzell for George Palmer, as appears by the copies remaining in my office, and now Nov 3d 1834, the above adjoining two tracts of land situated in Plainfield Township resurveyed into one tract, to the Exeutors of the said George Happle now Deceased and contains fifty acres and one hundred and forty perches and the allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
