The above Drafts No-1, 2, & 3 describe a Parcel of Land situate in Fannet Township in the County of Franklin containing in the whole one hundred and fifty six Acres and an half and an Allowance of Six P. Cent. for Roads &c. Survey'd in one Tract January 10th 1770 under the Direction of John Armstrong Esq. late Dy. Surveyor in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Jonathan Kearsley bearing Date the 2d Day of June 1762, and soon laid out in the above three Divisions, - Matthew Henderson, by virtue of sundry Conveyances, now claiming the Divisions No-1 & 3, and Hugh McCurdy in like Manner claiming that of No 2. The Draft No 4 describes a Tract of Land situate in the same Township & County containing two hundred and thirteen acres and the allowance aforesaid Survey'd November 8th 1785 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Margaret Henderson bearing date the 2d Day of July 1785.
