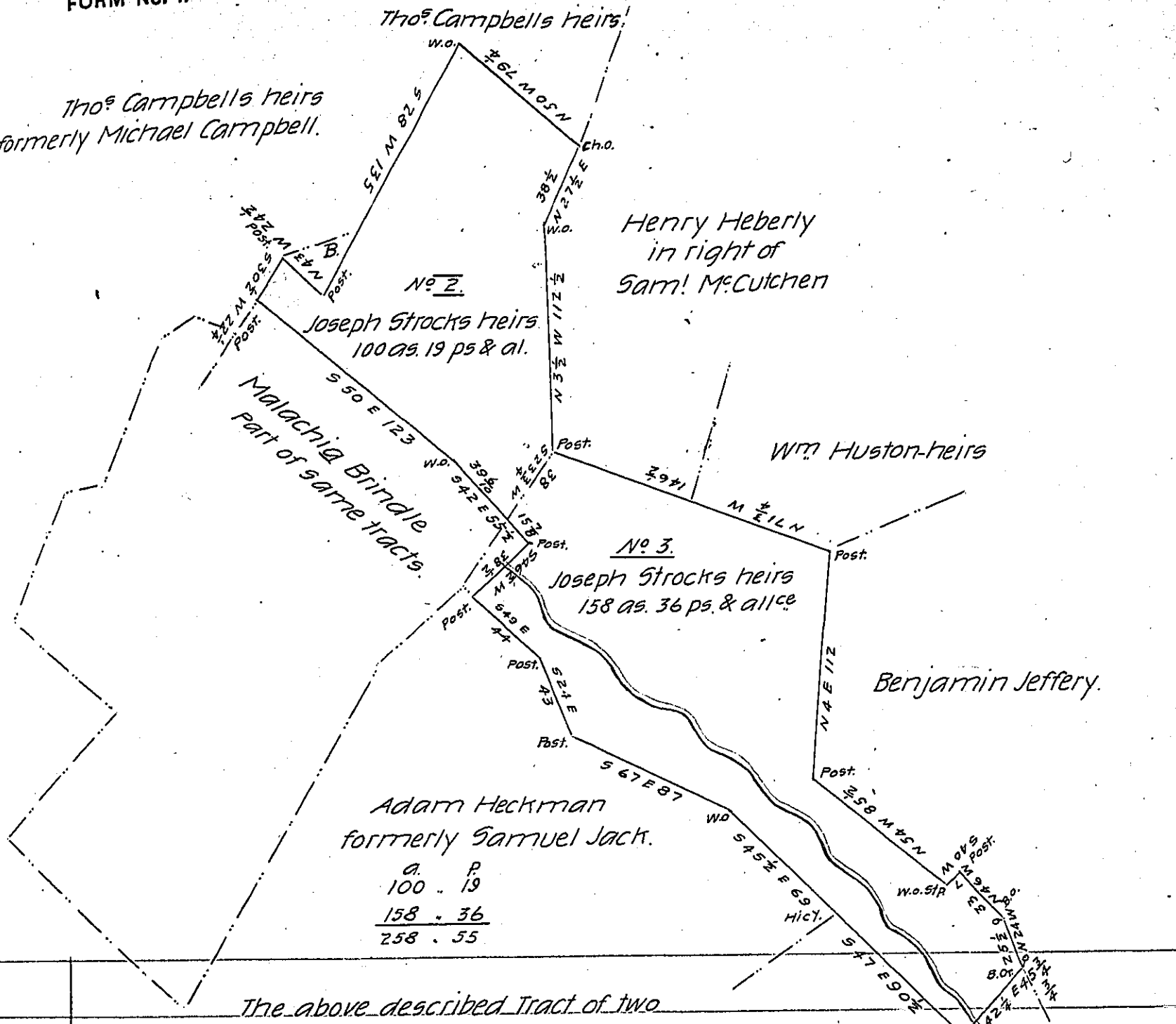


Tho^s Campbell's heirs

The above described Tract of two hundred and fifty-eight Acres & fifty-five perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c is a part of two larger Tracts of Land, situate in St Thomas Township, Franklin County; (formerly Peters Township Cumberland County) to wit: No 2 containing 100 as 19 ps & allowance, is part of a tract of 343 as 56 ps & allowance which was surveyed the 27th May 1768 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Holliday bearing date the 14th December 1742, No 3 containing 158 as 36 ps & allowance is part of a tract of 143 as 55 ps & allowance, surveyed the same day, in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Holliday, bearing date the 6th of April 1744. Resurveyed and divided off for the heirs of Joseph Strack decd the 27th November 1822 Wm S Davis D.S.
