



Situate in Friend's Cove in Colerain township Bedford County containing two hundred and twenty-three acres and allowance of six per cent. Surveyed for Robert Love on order No 1799 dated the 4th day of November 1766

No 1 represents a survey made for Michal Roof on warrant dated the 11th day of March 1794 this tract interferes seventy-six acres and twenty-four perches with the Robt Love survey Michal Roof conveyed to John Keegg who also Bought from John Anderson who claimed under Robert Love John Keegg conveyed to Nicholas Border whose widow & heirs now own the same No 2 represents part of a survey made for Robert Fagan on warrant dated the 11th day May 1785 this Survey interferes twentyfive acres with the Robt Love sur-v-y Robt Fagan conveyed to Felix Mellon who abandoned his claim to this land.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty-second day of June 1905.
